The program would cost \$15 where \$5 goes to Safe Shed, \$5 to the Academic Foundation, and \$5 to the band.

James Toth showed the Foundation web page that now includes a mechanism to donate on-line through PayPal. The fee structure of the donation to a 501(c)3 organization is around 5% of the transaction. There was discussion about the opportunities for donations, scholarships, and paying membership fees.
