Minutes

John Gaston reviewed the treasurer's report which showed a December 31, 2025 balance of \$389,183.02. Mr. Gaston reminded the directors that approximately \$139,000 will go out to help pay for the science lab renovation.

John Gaston reviewed the profit loss statement that showed a profit of \$988.39 for the month which ended December 31, 2025. A total profit for the year to date is \$5,009.94.

A motion was made by Don Decker, seconded by Dena Heflin, to receive the treasurer's report.

Vote: 8 ayes, 0 nay, motion carried.

John Gaston reported that the tax return is completed and filed for the fiscal year. There will be the expense filing as well as the fee for the CPA work.

Committee Reports

Membership-\$2,100 has come in from membership dues. The newsletter was presented for review and typically there is an increase in membership payment when the newsletter is mailed.

Publicity-There will be an article on the Harris donation to assist in the science renovation when the plaque is installed.

Scholarship-No report.

Hall of Fame-There was discussion about the upcoming Hall of Fame applications and selection. Debby Hays had information on Ryan Burge. Lynette Dye discussed Dr. Jeffrey McClain as a possible candidate and John Gaston talked about Tony Harris as a potential candidate.

Fundraising-Brad Detering outlined the halftime activities and reminded the directors that the amount of \$425 per sponsor was guaranteed without having to worry about making baskets.
